



Spit to Manly Walk

Dear Parents,

SWAG is planning a day outing on 22nd February 2020 – the Spit to Manly walk. All SWAG boys, families and friend are welcome.

The Spit Bridge to Manly Scenic Walkway is a series of short tracks, mostly less than 1-2km, including the Fairlight, Dobroyd and North Harbour walks. Each track covers a themed section of the harbour, so covering all of them in one walk is a great way to experience the diversity of Sydney Harbour's bays, beaches and bushland.

The program for the day will be:

1. Train to the city
2. Bus to Spit Bridge (#178-180 from Wynyard)
3. 4 hr for walk to Manly (with breaks)
Lunch at Clontarf Reserve
Free time for play or swim
4. Manly Ferry return to Circular Quay
5. Train to Hurstville



Time: **9:45am at Hurstville Presbyterian Church.** – return around 4:30pm
The outing will be 6-7 hrs (depending on transport connections)

Cost **Please bring own Opal card** (approx. \$8 boys)

What to bring Wear suitable clothes and shoes for walking
Backpack
Hat, Sunscreen, Insect repellent
Lunch, snacks
Water / bottle at least 1 litre (refillable)
Swimmers / towel – if you'd like to swim

Families are welcome to make alternative travel plans (eg. Meet at Wynyard bus interchange), please discuss with SWAG leaders.
